



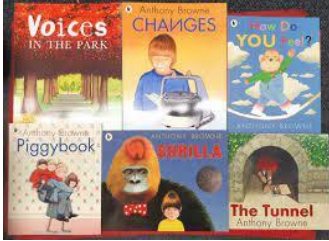

Autumn 1 Term

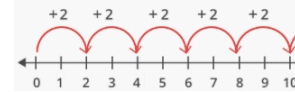
Reading

Our author focus is Anthony Browne. We will be enjoying and discussing his stories.



Maths

In Maths, we are focusing on addition and subtraction of two 2-digit numbers. We continue to use our knowledge of bonds to ten to support mental strategies when adding and subtracting. We will also be practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s in preparation for our times tables.



English

Our whole school focus will be on reading and writing using Dan Santat's 'After the Fall'; a heartwarming story about overcoming challenges in life.

As a school we will be focusing on the theme of resilience. We will be writing from Humpty Dumpty's point of view. Art and PSHE lessons will also link with this book.

PE

This half term, we will be developing our skills in Athletics and Games. Children are reminded to bring their PE kit in a PE bag.

Science

In Science, we are looking at 'Animals Including Humans'. Children will be learning about what animals need to stay alive. We will be applying enquiry skills, observing over time and identifying groups and classifying.

History

In History, we are learning about the Great Fire of London. We will describe differences between London in 1666 and now. We will look into why the fire spread so quickly and why it was so destructive.



Computing

In Computing, the children will be developing their programming skills by looking at simple algorithm sequences. They will learn how to create a successful algorithm and what debugging is.



Art

We will be learning about the work and styles of Impressionism, Monet, Renoir and Jan Griffier and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

RE

We are learning about Hinduism and how Hindus celebrate Diwali around the world. We will be learning about the very first Diwali.



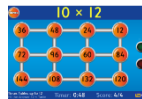
PSHE
