



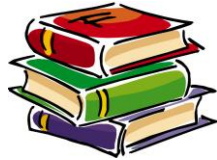
# Kidbrooke Park Primary School

## Year 3 Curriculum Overview

### Autumn 1 Term

#### Reading

Our author focus is Roald Dahl, regarded as one of the greatest child authors, who at one point in his life, lived in Bexley Village. Even though lots of children are becoming fluent readers, it is still valuable for them to spend time reading with you and talking about what they have read.



#### Maths

For this half term, we shall be starting by looking at place value of digits within numbers to 1,000, such as partitioning them into Thousands, Hundreds, Tens and Ones as well as comparing numbers using  $<$ ,  $>$  and  $=$ . After this, we will begin addition and subtraction, again up to 1,000 with a particular focus of adding and with and without bridging 10, such as in  $34+21$  or  $34 + 27$ .

#### English



The school will be exploring London landmarks with Year 3 focusing on The Tower of London. 'The Queen's token' by Pamela Oldfield is set in Tudor times, and we will start with a setting description. Following this, we will be looking at retelling the story from a different point of view.

#### Science

In Science, we will continue to develop our Scientific enquiry skills through the topic Rocks and Soils. We will plan, conduct and evaluate several different experiments. We will be using the results of our experiments to help us solve a 'real life' problem.



#### Geography

Our key question will be: What is the difference between a rural and urban area? We shall be focusing on identifying these different concepts within Britain and looking at human and physical features.



#### Times Tables

All children have a national times table test in Year 4. To help prepare them, we will be ensuring that pupils leave Year 3 with solid knowledge of x2, x5, x10, x4 and x8 tables. Other tables can still be learned. Times Table Rockstar logins will be provided to support learning.



#### Computing

This half term, children will learn to compose and mix music through the Garageband app on iPads to create their own complex compositions.



#### Art

This half term, children will discover Australian aboriginal art, focusing on Emily Kngwarreye's work.



#### RE

For the first half term, we shall be looking at how different religions look at the creation of the world. This unit will also look at non-religious views such as the Big Bang Theory.

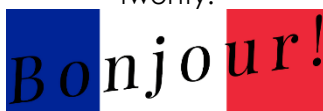


#### PSHE
