



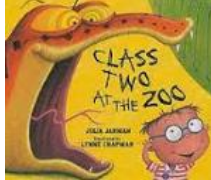

Autumn 2 Term

Reading

Maths

In Maths, we are continuing with our unit on addition and subtraction of two 2-digit numbers. We continue to use our knowledge of bonds to ten to support mental strategies when adding and subtracting. As well, we will be practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s in preparation for our times tables.



English

Following Year 2's fantastic trip to the theatre, we will be reading and then writing our own versions of the traditional tale of the Three Little Pigs. We will be discussing and writing about the characters of the pigs and the Wolf as well as honing our narrative writing skills. Perhaps you know some different traditional tales you could share!

We start the half term with some poetry! The children will study a poetic genre and then write their own poems in a similar style.

PE

Our focus this half term will be yoga and ball skills.

Please ensure the children have their PE kit on their PE days. PE is an essential part of the curriculum.

Science

In Science we will be continuing to learn about Animals including Humans. Our focus this term will be linked to DT- we will be thinking about how to live a healthy and happy life. Children will be discussing all the things they can do to take care of their bodies.

Geography

We are looking at Countries, Capital Cities and Continents. Can you name the & continents? Can you name the 5 oceans of the world?



Computing

The internet has become an essential part of modern-day life. We will be looking at search engines and how to surf the web safely.

We will be looking at how we can use data and how it can be displayed. E safety will also feature in our learning.



DT

We will be studying healthy food and eating. We will answer the following questions:

- What are healthy foods?
- What foods give us energy?
- What foods go well together?
- Where does our food come from?
- Why is it important to keep hydrated?

RE

In RE, we will continue finding out about Hinduism, it's traditions and beliefs.

We will be learning more about life as a Hindu and how and where Hindus worship.



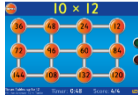
PSHE
