Reading

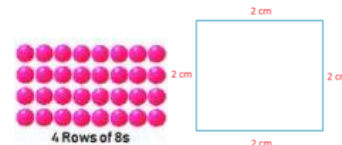

Anne Fine was born in Leicester, and she was the nation's second Children's Laureate between 2001 and 2003. Also in 2003, Anne Fine was awarded an OBE for her services to literature.

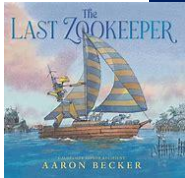


Maths

For this half term, we shall be continuing with multiplication and division, investigating the 8x table before moving onto learning how to multiply and divide a two-digit number by a one-digit number. Following this, we shall start our next unit on length and perimeter of shape. This unit will also involve learning how to measure in millimetres, centimetres and metres.



English



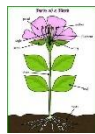
We are starting the half term by writing a character description

Science

We shall be learning about plants and how they grow, including learning the factors that impact their growth.



Geography

Our second Geography unit of the year will explore rivers and notably how the River Thames has influenced the development of London and learning about the key physical features of rivers.

This half term, please focus on learning their 4 and 8 times tables and using Times Table Rock Stars.



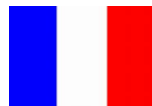
Computing
