Maths

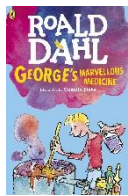

$$\square \times 3 = 9$$

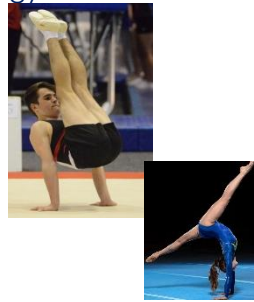
English

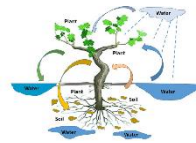
PE

Our question will be to see how a place of worship help Christians to develop their beliefs about Jesus? This will involve a short trip to a local church.



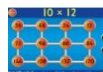
PSHE
